The *Herald's* travelling exhibition of famous front pages, which has been touring public spaces and universities for the last year, was shown at the Universidad de Palermo recently. The house decided to establish a prize for students who delivered the best essay on some news item shown in the front pages displayed. The contest was won by Hernán Dobry, who recently graduated from the Universidad de Palermo, for his essay inspired by the news coverage of the death of tango legend Carlos Gardel, in the *Herald* on June 25, 1935. The *Herald* has published a booklet collecting 80 covers that recorded historic moments. *Front Pages that Made History* (9.90 pesos) collects front pages of this paper between 1876 and 2005.
